With reference to your application on the above cited subject I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education for upgradation of the school from Secondary level to Sr. Secondary level with Humanities and Commerce Stream w.c.f. 2001-2002 without aid subject to the following terms and conditions and in accordance with Rule-52 of DSER 1973.

The upgradation from Secondary to Sr. Secondary level in Humanities and Commerce Stream w.c.f. session 2001-2002 without aid under Rule-52 of DSER, 1973 has been approved with the condition that the discrepancies and deficiencies given below shall be removed by the school within a period of six months from the date of the letter granting recognition. If the Managing Committee of the school omits or fails to remove any of the discrepancies or deficiencies within a period of six months as stipulated and stated above the recognition to the classes-XI & XII granted to the school will automatically lapse without any intimation or notice to the Managing Committee of the school.

Discrepancies and deficiencies

1. As far as the utility of the land (Masjid Meth site) is concerned the Management of the school may sort out the matter with Delhi Development Authority and report accordingly to this office with the relevant documents.
2. Building Plan sanctioned by competent legal authority is required.
3. Fresh structural stability certificate required.
4. Fresh building completion certificate from the competent local authority required.

- 5. Salary and allowances must be paid to the employees as per the recommendations of the 7th Pay Commission Report.
- 6. Some of the staff members are over-aged, some are on adhoc and some are on consolidated salary. Regular staff must be appointed as per recruitment rules.

Terms & Conditions

- 1. That the school shall abide by the provision of DSER, 1973 and Rules framed thereunder as well as instructions issued by the Dte. of Education from time to time.
- 2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed and as per the norms of the Deptt.
- 3. That the school should always appoint full time qualified and eligible staff as per the norms of the Deptt.
- 4. The school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
- 5. That the school shall strictly abide by the provision of Section-10(1) of DSER, 1973.
- 6. That the service contract between the Management and the employees be revised as per DSER, 1973 and shall be executed immediately. The copies of the appointment letter is to be issued to the staff and also provided for verification.
- 7. The Managing Committee shall regulate the functioning of the school strictly in accordance with the provision of DSER, 1973.

8. That the school shall strictly not run any unauthorised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at the place at the premises of the school immediately, if any.
9. That the school Library shall be maintained properly and the facilities for reading shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 1:10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.
10. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students.
11. That the Sc. Lab. have to be improved/maintained/renovated by the school from time to time.
12. The Managing Committee of the school shall not increase fee without prior approval of the Dte. of Education which is mandatory requirement under sub-sec. 17 of DSER, 1973.
13. That the school shall restrict the enrolment in every class to the ratio of 10 sq.ft. per student.
14. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule-50 and 51 of DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
15. That the arrangement for good drinking water and sanitary facilities be made available to the students and teachers of the school.
16. That the staff has been paid all the arrears and are being paid salary as per Vth Pay commission recommendations. Pay to be given to E.O. of the Zone for verification.
17. Medical facilities/leave, LTC, bonus, teaching allowance, medical allowance, PF etc. be paid since recognition of the school.
18. Provident Fund register, each book is to be maintained and completed and shown to E.O. of the Zone for verification from time to time.
19. That the Management of the school shall create a reserve fund to the tune of 3 months salary of the staff or one rupees plus 80 rupees per student, whichever is less in joint account in the name of Deputy Director of Education South and the Manager of the School in a Nationalised Bank.
20. That the school shall strictly comply with the Supreme Court Orders regarding the transport facilities in the school.
21. That the school shall submit returns under Rule-189 of DSER, 1973 to Addl. DE(Sch) and to Zonal office every year in the month of July.





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- 8) That all the facilities prescribed under rule-50(5) of DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
- 9) That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and overage staff, if any, immediately and appoint qualified staff.
- 10) That the service contract between the Management and the employees be revised as per DSER, 1973 and shall be executed immediately.
- 11) The Managing Committee of the school shall regulate the functioning of the school strictly in accordance with the provision of DSER, 1973.
- 12) That the violation of any instructions/condition/rule/regulations of the Dpptt. shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
- 13) Managing Committee of the school shall not increase fees in future academic session without the prior approval of the Director of Education which is mandatory requirement under sub-section(3) of Section-17 of DSER, 1973.
- 14) The staff and employees of the school shall be paid salary and allowances as per the recommendations of the Fifth Pay Commission at par with Govt. school teachers.
- 15) Medical facilities, leave, LTC, bonus, teaching allowance, CPF be paid since the recognition of the school.
- 16) Provident Fund register to be maintained and cash register to be completed and shown to the Education Officer of the zone concerned for verification from time to time.
- 17) That the Management of the school shall create a reserve fund to the tune of three months salary to the staff of the school.
- 18) That the school shall restrict the enrolment in every class at the ratio of 10 sq.ft. per student.
- 19) That the arrangement for good drinking water shall be made available to the students and the teachers and sanitary facilities shall be provided to the students and teachers.
- 20) That the Science Lab have to be made available in the school and improved/renovated from time to time.
