






3. In this lockdown period, you must have helped your parents in many ways at home. Write 5-6 lines for each activity saying what you did and why you liked doing it.


4. Make a beautiful bookmark for a book you are going to read this summer. Decorate it and write a famous quotation on it.



Mathematics


- a) Learn the tables from 2 to 15 in the dodging form.

Parents are requested to help the students develop basic conversational skill. They are as follows:

The teachers are trying to encourage the children to use simple words, phrases and sentences like:-

- **May I go to play?**
- **May I borrow your pencil / eraser / sharpener?**
- **I have finished my work.**
- **Madam, may I go to the washroom?**
- **Madam, may I go to drink water please?**
- **Madam, may I go to wash my hands?**
- **Madam, may I sit in the first row as I can't see from the back?**
- **Madam, I have lost my shoes / blazer / tiffin box / water bottle etc.**
- **Madam, I'm sorry. I have forgotten to bring my book, note book / pencil / eraser / drawing book.**
- **Madam, I'm sorry I couldn't complete my homework as I was unwell.**
- **Madam, may I borrow a pencil / eraser / ruler etc. From my partner as I've forgotten to bring mine today.**
- **Can you please, shut the door?**

Use of MAGIC WORDS like excuse me, sorry, thank you, please.

- **When asking for something says "Please."**
 - **When receiving something, say "Thank you."**
 - **Do not interrupt grown-ups who are speaking with each other unless there is an emergency.**
 - **If you need to attain someone's attention right away, then the phrase of "Excuse me" should be used precisely.**
 - **When you go over to spend time at your friend's place, remember thank his / her parents for having you over and for the good time you had spending your day before you leave.**
 - **Knock on closed doors and wait to see if there's a response before entering.**
- **Children can be encouraged to use simple words and sentences at home also.**
- For example-**
- **Mummy, can I help you in the kitchen?**
 - **Mummy, should I help you wash the dishes today?**
 - **Papa, can I help you wash the car?**
 - **Grandpa, should I come with you for a walk?**
 - **Mummy, may I take some more Ice-cream from the fridge?**
 - **Papa, please teach me how to ride a bicycle.**
 - **Mummy, should I cut the salad today?**
 - **Papa, can we go cycling together today?**

- **Wishing people properly- Hello Uncle/ Aunty how are you?**
- **Wishing parents and elders Good Morning, Good Afternoon, Good Evening and Good Night.**

If we, as teachers and parents make a sincere and cohesive effort and pay attention to the above mentioned points, we can help our children become much more dignified, courteous and well behaved human beings. Alongside, will surely help them learn, understand and speak English at an early stage which will result in making those well versed and confident individuals.
